## **VIETNAM ENERGY TRANSITION WEEKLY UPDATE**

## **Key points**

- 1. Electricity consumption is <u>projected</u> to increase at a record high of over 13% this summer. This will exert significant pressure on the power generation system.
- 2. PM Chinh <u>commits</u> that Vietnam will ensure sufficient power for business and production activities. Of all the initiatives to ensure national power security, the Quang Trach Pho Noi 500 kV line circuit 3 project is of paramount importance.
- 3. Deputy PM Tran Hong Ha <u>highlighted</u> the importance of rooftop solar power in ensuring energy security, saying that there needs to be mechanisms and policies to encourage organisations and individuals to invest in solar power.
