## **VIETNAM ENERGY TRANSITION WEEKLY UPDATE**

## **Key points**

- 1. Implementation Plan (IP) for National Energy Master Plan 2021 2030 with a vision toward 2050 has been approved. The IP aims to:
  - Effectively implement the National Energy Master Plan which was approved in last July.
  - Identify specific projects and determine implementation progress of programs and projects toward 2030.
  - Provide guidance for relevant agencies in implementing the master plan.

The total capital demand for Vietnam's energy sector is estimated at approximately 190 billion USD during 2021 – 2030.

- 2. As severe hot weather caused electricity consumption in the country to increase to a record <u>high</u>, EVN is <u>mobilizing</u> all coal-fired power plants and many gas-fired power plants.
- 3. PetroVietnam GAS, Vietnam's leading gas company, receives third LNG shipment for power generation.
